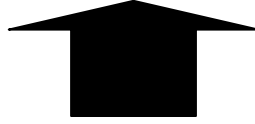

Workit! A Pathway to a Career in the Apprenticable Trades

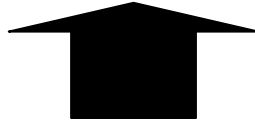
## Successful Career as a Journeyman

- Further post-secondary education



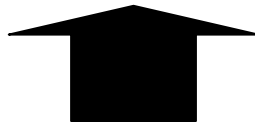
## Working Full-Time as an Apprentice

- Registered apprentice accumulating on-the-job training hours, theory and skills toward a trade



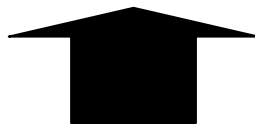
## Choosing a Training Option

- Continue with employer as an apprentice



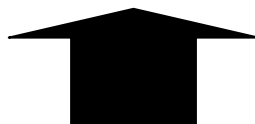
## Youth Apprenticeship
